Our school has enjoyed celebrating World Water Day with some famous poems by Italian and English authors. Poems on: water, rain, snow and fog.



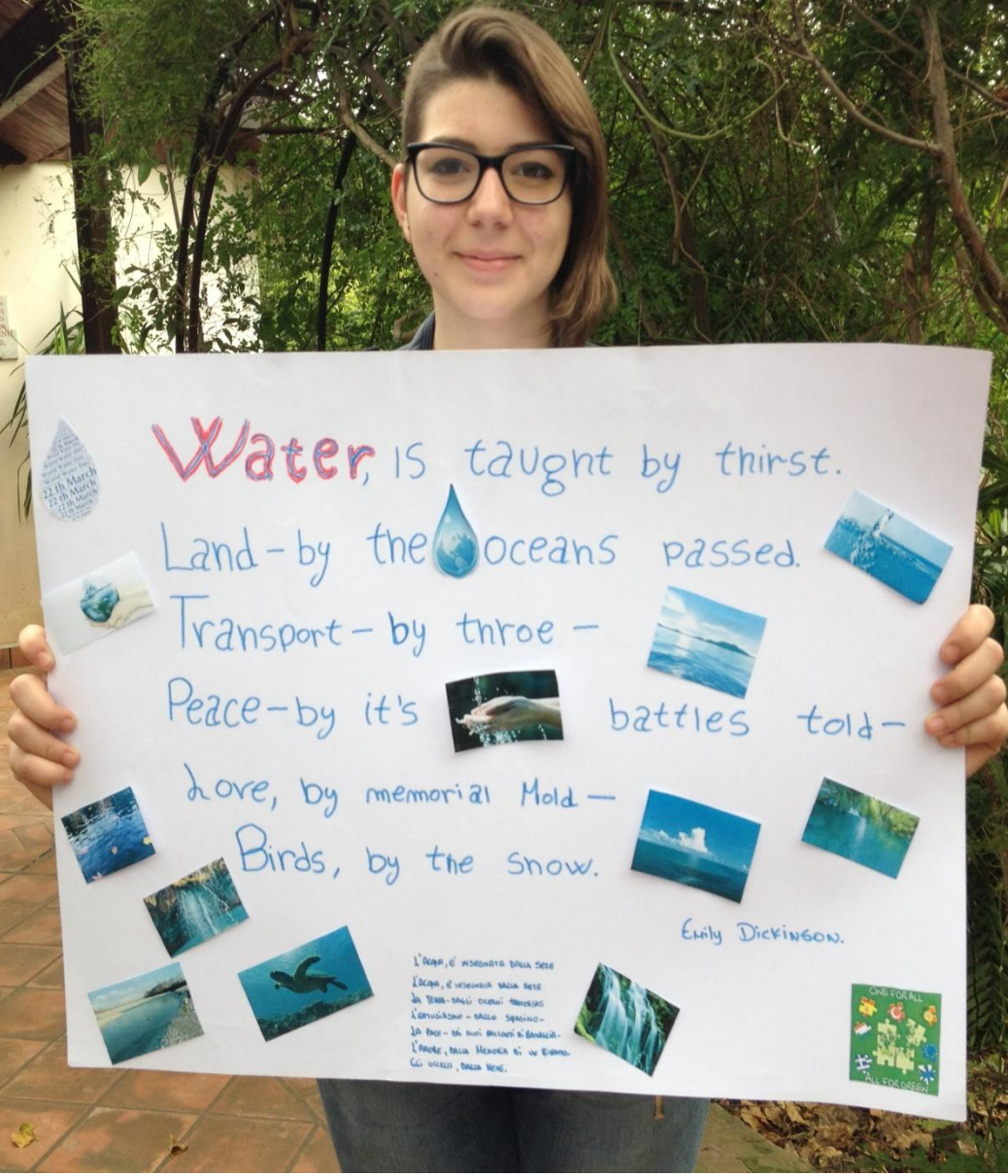
Upon the fields and the streets

Transport - by throe -

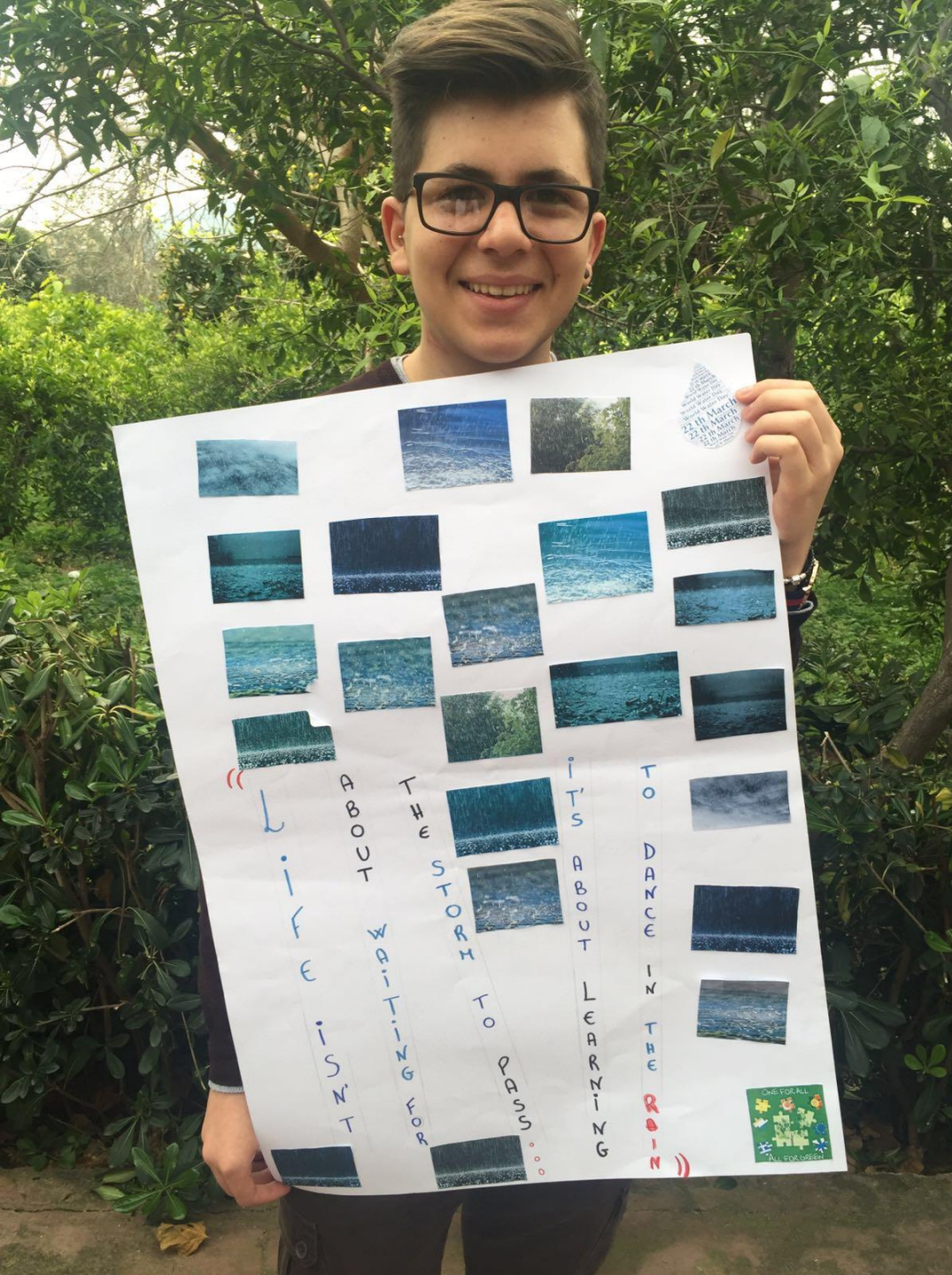
Peace - by it's battles told -

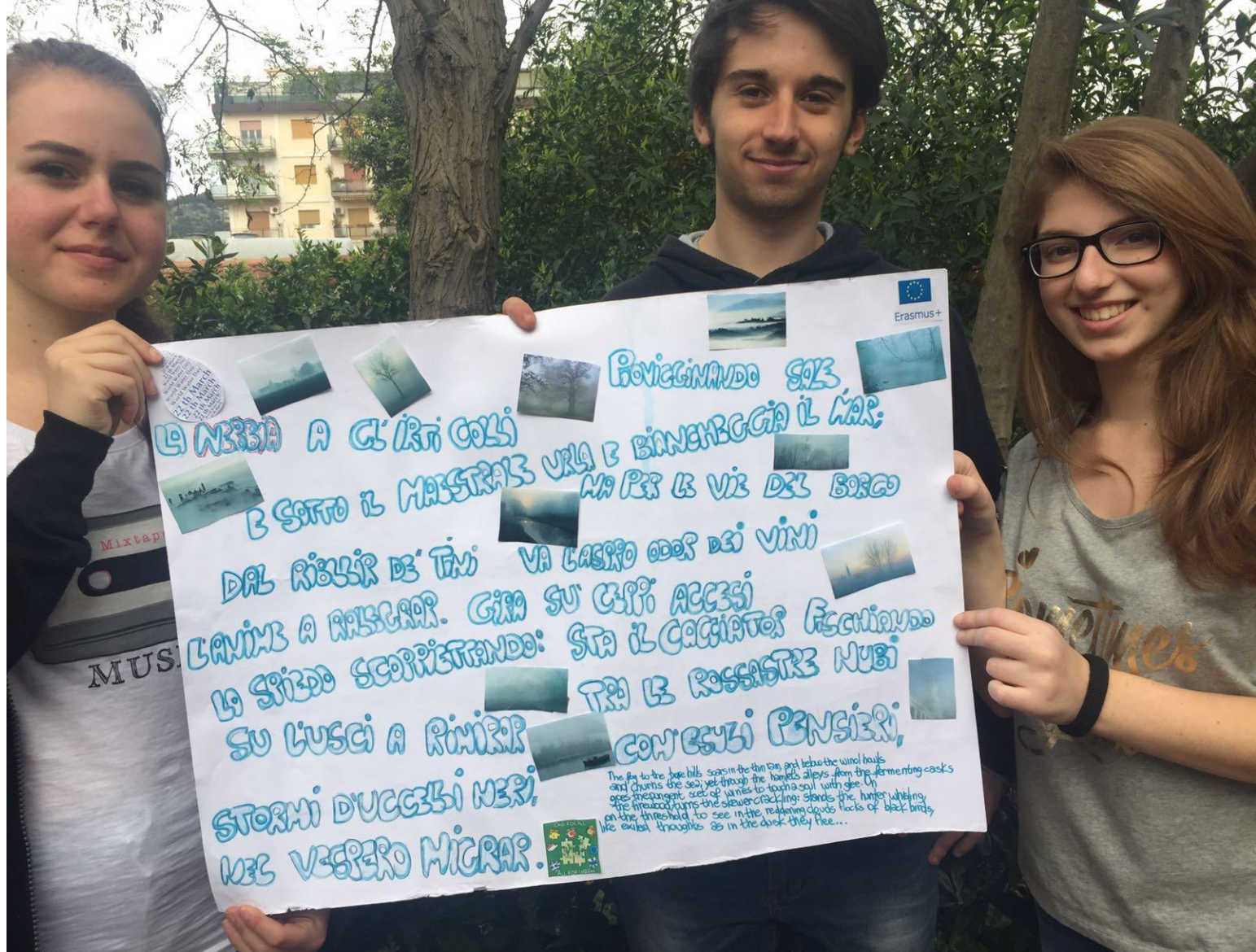

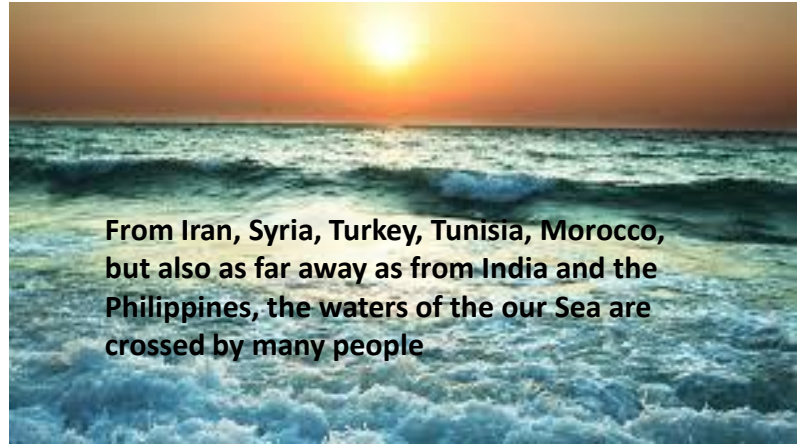

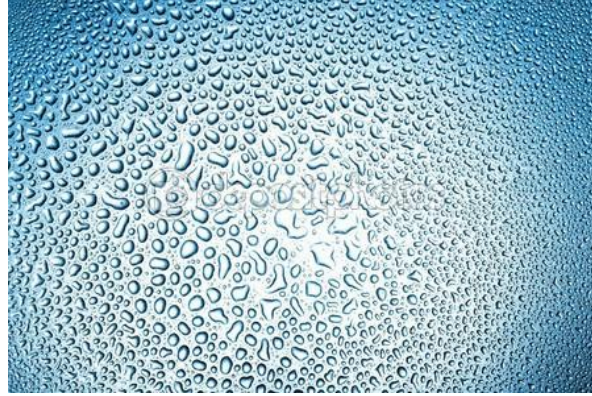

The Mediterranean sea water is the search for a better life for many people. So, we have represented our Sea in a original way.

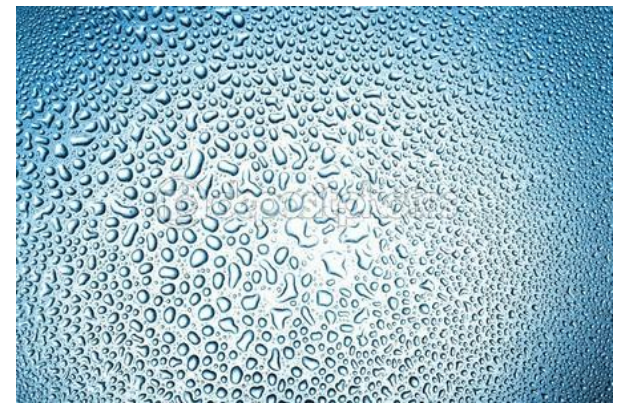
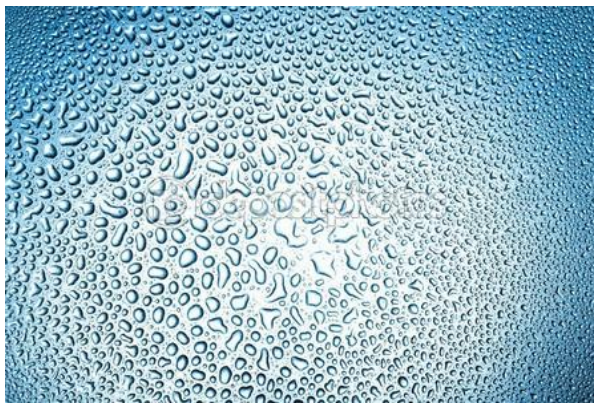
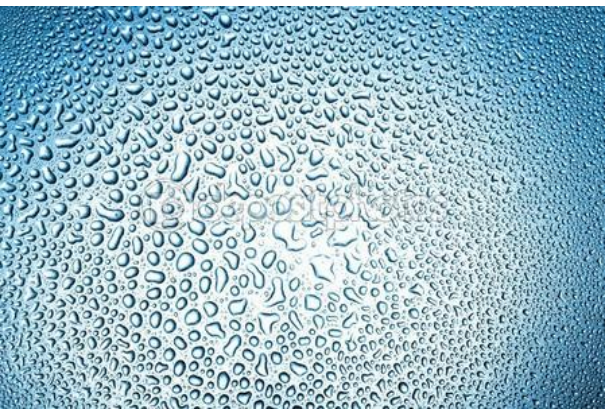


From Iran, Syria, Turkey, Tunisia, Morocco, but also as far away as from India and the Philippines, the waters of the our Sea are crossed by many people

THE 1868 CAST-IRON FOUNTAIN WAS
DESIGNED AND BUILT BY THE SCULPTOR
FRANCOIS GARDON. IT IS THE ONLY
ONE OF ITS KIND AND STANDS AN
IMPRESSIVE EIGHT METRES TALL AS
THE CENTREPIECE OF THE FOUNTAIN
GARDENS IN PARIS.
